The Ohio Air Quality Development Authority is a non-regulatory state agency focused on protecting air as a natural resource in the State of Ohio while stimulating economic benefits by assisting in the financing of air quality facilities. Its five public members are appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Ohio Senate. Two members serve in an ex officio capacity, representing the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Department of Health.
